Introduction

National recognition

These competencies have been drawn from the nationally endorsed industry-training package the HLT Health Training Package release 1.0. On successfully completing the training and assessment, a Statement of Attainment will be issued for the following units HLTAID003 Provide First Aid & HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

The units of competence are nationally recognised and can be applied throughout Australia.

Program outline

The Course will be delivered via e-learning prior to practical and Assessment workshop Trainer led, face-to-face in a classroom setting combined with skills practice. Participants will be provided with professionally presented reference material that they will be working through the entire course to assist them to develop their knowledge of the subjects.

Expected duration

The program is designed to be delivered over 1 day (6 hours) providing e-learning is completed prior to attending the First Aid Workshop.

Assessment requirements

The unit of competency will be assessed using assessment methods including a knowledge assessment and a practical observation assessment. This allows for the discrete assessment of specific knowledge and the assessment of knowledge integrated with skills during practical assessment activities performing first aid.

There are two assessments activities for the assessment of HLTAID003 Provide first aid, these are:

Method	Description
Knowledge Test	The candidate must provide a written or verbal response to 90 multiple-choice questions, which address the knowledge requirement of providing first aid. You must answer all questions correctly.
Observation	The candidate must complete 10 First Aid emergency simulated scenarios.

In addition there are three assessments activities for the assessment of HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation, these are:

Method	Description
Written Knowledge Test	The candidate must provide a written or verbal response to 19 multiple choice questions which address the knowledge requirement of performing CPR.
Practical Assessment	The candidate must be observed responding to a simulated emergency scenario requiring CPR.
Verbal Quiz	The candidate must provide suitable responses to verbal questions about CPR technique and procedure.

Entry requirements

There are no specified entry requirements for this training program.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Students must notify Urban Training Academy of their interest or intention to apply for RPL prior to their enrolment. If a student is requesting RPL for HLTAID003 Provide First Aid & HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation the process at Urban Training Academy is that the student must provide a Statement of Attainment as proof of having completed the unit they wish

to have RPL, this will exempt them from having to redo the learning and fast track the students straight to the assessment workshop.

Student Information
